EXECUTIVE PRESIDENT'S REPORT TO THE 14TH IDBF CONGRESS 2013

2013 年第十届国际龙联代表大会执行主席报告

The Executive President's Report to the 14th IDBF Congress given at the Hotel Forrás, Szeged, Hungary, on Monday 29th July 2013.

The past two years have been ones of consolidation for the Federation, especially within the world of international sports federations. The IDBF has established itself within SportAccord – the parliment of International Sports Federsations, as the only World Governing Body for Dragon Boating and the Association of Independent Sportaccord Members – AIMS for short, which encompasses all the Non Olympic Sports, has been formed within Sportaccord, to look after the common interests of its members. I am a Member of the AIMS Working Group, so the IDBF is well placed politically within SportAccord.

This year's SportAccord Annual General Assembly, held in St Petersburg, was of particular importance as a new SportAccord President was elected on the retirement of Hein Verbruggen, the long serving President. The new SportAccord President is Marius Vizer from the Judo Federation (President) and we wish him every success in the challenging and demanding role of the SportAccord President.

IDBF Officials have met regularly with the World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA) and after considerable discussions I am pleased to report that following a revision of our Anti=Doping Policy to include out of competition testing, the IDBF is now fully compliant with the WADA Code, which is a prerequiste of being recognised by the International Olympic Committee (IOC).

In this regard I can inform the Congress that the IDBF Application for IOC Recognition has been submitted to the IOC Sports Department and whilst our application has not yet gone forward to the IOC Executive Committee, we are meeting with IOC Officials shortly to discuss how the IDBF can address those aspects for IOC Recognition that Dragon Boating as a Sport, does not meet at present. In their letter to the IDBF, the IOC Officers said:-

"We appreciate all the effort invested in this application process and we would like to organise a debrief session to provide you with detailed feedback on the aspects that could be improved in your application. We remain at your disposal to discuss the format of the debrief session and we trust that we will be able to work with the IDBF to further advance its development"

This is encouraging news and clearly shows that the IOC accepts the IDBF's status as the SportAccord recognised World Governing Body for our Sport. A status confirmed by the Court of Arbitration for Sport (CAS) in 2008 and notified to International Canoe Federation (ICF) at that time.

Within the Sport our Membership continues to grow with over 70 Countries and Territories now in the IDBF family of which more than 40 have competed internationally or in IDBF World Championships Regattas. Our 2012 Club Crew Championshipos in Hong Kong, which marked the 21st Anniversary of the IDBF's foundation in Hong Kong, saw nearly 5000 participants.

This year in Szeged we had the biggest number of IDBF Members competing in a World Nations Championship so far, with 44 Members provisionally entering of which 33 confirmed their participation. Unforunately financial problems and visa difficulties reduced this number still further to just below 30 but still the highest number of Countries at any World Dragon Boat Championships.

However, ensuring that our World Championships are within the finacial reach of our Members and accesable to all Representative Teams, is a challenge that the IDBF Council and Championship Organising Committees must address, as a matter of priority, if the success of our World Championships in the future is to be assured.

The IDBF Development Boats Scheme, in which the IDBF sends Dragon Boats to new and developing Countries, is working well, with donated boats going to Ghana, Uganda, Senegal, Cyprus, the Philippines in the past 2 years and boats in the pipeline for Serbia, Costa Rico and nominally the Cameroons.

Donated Boats and Paddles are now part of the IDBF Partners Scheme, as well as the alternative to manufacturers paying IDBF License Fees but, as always when it involves money, progress is at a slow pace. Registered for 2013 are 5 IDBF Platinum Partners, 1 Gold Partner and 4 Bronze Partners. They are,

Platinum Partners - Buk, Champion, Pei Sheng (Boats). Grey Owl, Braca (Paddles)

Gold Partners - Swift International (Boats)

Bronze Partners - Burnwater, G Power, Trivium, Swift (Paddles)

For the scheme to develop and be maintained, including making sure that the Partners get the benefits due to them from the IDBF, there now needs to be a specific IDBF Official designated to oversee, supervise and if necessary work with the Partners directly. Such a role is one that could be undertaken by one of the IDBF VPs.

I believe that the IDBF as a volunteer run organisation does not have enough of its elected officials helping to run the IDBF on a day to day basis. To much work is being placed on the shoulders of too view people.

This situation must change if the IDBF is to develop the Sport effectively any further. I believe that the Vice Presidents should be given a more active and worthwhile role in running the affairs of the IDBF.

This year I have identified what I consider to be some key areas of the IDBF's work which could be shared between the VPs. I have asked the Council to incorporate these specific portfolios into the IDBF Bye-Laws so that both the IDBF Members and the VPs know what these specific tasks are.

Further to the IOC Recognition application, I believe that we need to amend our Bye-Laws concerning the Continental Federations to bring our Sport into line with the IOC, regarding which Countries can compete in Olympic Movement Continental Games, such as the Asian Games etc. Bye Law amendments will bring us into line with the Olympic Movement and clarify the Membership of our Continental Federations.

May I conclude on a personal note and that is to thank the IDBF Members, IDBF Officers, Officials and my many,many friends and collegues within the Sport for their kind and comforting thoughts over this past year since the unexpected death of my best friend and wife Phyll MacKeddie, one of the founding officials of modern Dragon Boating.

Without such support I would have found it very difficult to have continued as your Executive President or indeed at all over the past 12 months. Unfortunately grief is the price we pay for love and the stronger the love, the deeper the pain. Thank you again for your support.

IDBF TREASURERS REPORT FOR FINANCIAL YEARS 2011 AND 2012

SITUATION OF THE 2012 ACCOUNTS

The 2012 balance sheet shows an excess of income of US\$ 44.180. The very successful 2012 World Club Crew Championships contributed to this result considerably. On the other hand the lack of other major sources of income is worrying. Therefore we have to keep searching for opportunities and try to develop sources of income that will generate a constant flow of income.

The extra income compared to previous years enabled us to spend more money on development of the sport in new dragon boat countries.

Other expenditure was within budget. Overall, the balance sheet shows an improvement of our capital to US\$ 76.445.

Because of logistic problems the figures and annual accounts have not yet been audited, so there is no Audit Report available yet. We will make sure that the book entries and records will be made available to the auditors as quickly as possible after the closing of the IDBF Congress.

ASSUMPTIONS FOR THE FUTURE

We continue to develop a number of alternative sources of income. The internet seems the best opportunity to achieve this. We started talks in 2012 with YouTube Sports, through SportAccord, and the general opinion is that a Dragon Boat Channel is viable. But the development will take much time, so no income is expected on a short term.

Also the income from World Championships is not expected to be as abundant in 2013, so we expect to be on a tighter budget for the current year and the next year.

RECOMMENDATIONS

Irespectfully ask the IDBF Council to accept the accounts and for the IDBF Congress gathered in Szeged on 29th July 2013, to approve the Balance Sheet and Accounts for 2012, with the provision of approval from the auditors.

- ACCOUNTING POLICIES. The principle accounting policies adopted in the preparation
 of the financial statements are set out below and have been consistently applied within
 these accounts.
 - a) Basis of preparation of financial statements

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention on the accruals basis.

The effect of events relating to the year ended 31 December 2012 and occurring before the date of approval of the financial statements by the Board, have been reflected in these statements.

b) Treatment of fixed assets

Computers and other items of office equipment have been written off when purchased and have not been capitalized on the basis that their cost is not material.

Live stream equipment has been acquired from the manufacturer at a reduced price, as a joint venture between the IOBF, the EDBF and the BOA

The IDBF owns a pool of dragon boats for development purposes, 22 at the year's end. These boats move around different countries on different continents, wherever they are needed to support new federations to develop the sport in their country. Because of the transport costs to move these boats to new areas to be developed, the value has been set at US\$ zero.

c} Foreign exchange

Transactions denominated in foreign currencies - if applicable - are translated into US dollar and recorded at an average rate of exchange ruling at the date of the transaction, as appropriate.

Balances at the year end denominated in a foreign currency are translated into US dollars at the rate of exchange ruling at the balance sheet date.

substantiated, accountable and transparent reporting of the financial affairs for IDBF. It will also allow for greater compliance and minimise any current financial operational risks. It will provide modern electronic accounting practices essential to meet the business needs of the organisation

- Firstly the accounts need to be audited annually and not bi-annually and financial reports tabled to the members annually at the first possible meeting following the audit finalisation. It is suggested that the reports be tabled within the timelines of the registering body or sooner if requested by the members.
- Financial reports illustrating the budget to actual revenue and expense be processed and reported on a regular basis to meet the operational requirements eg 6 monthly reports
- 3. All transactions for payments require all source documents attached to the payment advice and coded to the appropriate chart of account before payment is made. This will allow for greater transparency and substantiated accountability for payment.
- 4. It is strongly recommended that a web-based electronic accounting system be implemented with the finance team having access to the system. The web-based system will increase the ability to provide the strategic management team and members with timely reports as opposed to the current hand written manual accounting system where the reports are provided bi-annually. It will also allow for an electronic file to be provided to the auditor who can then use the electronic auditing tool for audit purposes.
- 5. As IDBF is a global organisation and only has a virtual office, it is recommended a web / cloud based filing system be established and that all source documents, bank statements and other business documents be scanned and saved to the file monthly. This will allow for approved users to have access to the documents and this will eliminate the current risk of only one person maintaining the accounts. It will also provide easy access to the filing system for documents to be forwarded to the auditor. All contracts for the organisation could be saved to the system at the time of signing the contract so the finance team can monitor the contract receipts or payments.
- 6. Financial policy and procedures manual to be written and approved.
- 7. All invoicing to be completed using the accounting software and aged reports analysed and followed up for outstanding payments continually.
- 8. It is recommended that a credit card be established for payment of accounts with an imprest value established on the card and payments electronically transferred between the credit card account and the operating bank account on a monthly basis or within the month if essential.

ENCLOSURE 4 TO THE 14TH IDBF CONGRESS MINUTES

Amendments notified by the IDBF Council to the Congress to take effect from 1 January 2014, unless otherwise stated, in accordance with the dates shown in the IDBF Statues.

AMENDMENT to the IDBF BYE LAWS, THE POST OF IDBF VICE-PRESIDENT

There have been four IDBF Vice-Presidents who are elected for a four year term at an IDBF Congress failing on an odd numbered year but from the 14th Congress in 2013, there will be elections for five Vice Presidents as the Chinese DBA, may nominate a 5th Vice-President and an IDBF President of Honour, under Article 40 of the IDBF Statutes, as revised by the 13th Members Congress, in Tampa, Florida, USA, on 8th August 2011. The roles of the Vice-Presidents as laid down in the IDBF Bye-Laws, are as follows:-

- **4.7 The Vice-Presidents.** The Senior Vice-President, as defined in Article 21 of the Statutes (that is, the Vice President who has held such Office the longest) shall be responsible for undertaking the duties of the Executive President or the President or any of the Officers of the Federation, whose duties are detailed in this Bye-Law, in the event that one or other of them is prevented from exercising the office concerned. In the event that more than one of the Officers is unavailable, then one or more of the other Vice Presidents, as the situation demands, shall assist the Senior Vice President in carrying out the work of the IDBF. Whilst so acting, the Vice Presidents shall enjoy the same rights as the Executive President or Officers of the Federation concerned.
 - **4.7.1 Duties and Responsibilities**: The duties and responsibilities outlined in this Bye-Law will be allocated by the Executive Committee according to the location, interests and experience of the Vice-Presidents as elected at the time. The duties and responsibilities of the Vice-Presidents will generally be:-
 - 1. Liasion with and supportig new IDBF members in developing the Sport.
 - 2. Supporting and advising the Chair-holders of the IDBF Commissions.
 - 3. Responsibility for matters of protocol and ceremonies at IDBF Championship Regattas.
 - 4. Liaison with International Sports Federations and Multi Sport Games in conjunction with and on behalf of, the Executive President
 - 5. Dealing with Membership issues; liaison with and visits to, the IDBF Members in conjunction with and on behalf of, the Executive President.
 - 6. Assisitng the Executive President in carrying out his or her duties.
 - **4.7.2** In addition to the general duties outlined above each Vice President will have a specific role to carry out in the organisation and administration of the IDBF. On their election the Vice Presidents' will indicate to the IDBF Members Congress the specific role (portfolio) that they wish to undertake on behalf of the IDBF Membership The specific roles are:
 - a. Responsible for matters of protocol and for ceremonies at IDBF Championship Regattas.
 - b. Responsible for the development of the Sport in new Countries and Territories.
 - c. Responsible for recording statistical information on the Sport, maintaining the IDBF historical records and the production of IDBF publications.
 - d. Responsible for Sponsorship matters and developing IDBF Partners and Patrons Schemes.
 - e. Responsible for developing the IDBF Affiliate Festivals Scheme and liaison with such IDBF Affiliates
- **4.8** The Vice-Presidents shall fulfil any specific tasks allocated to them by the IDBF Council, the Executive Committee, the Executive President or the President and *shall contribute, for example, to IDBF publications.* They shall report on all such activities.
 - **4.8.1** The Vice-Presidents may also assist the Officers of the Federation in carrying out their duties and under the authority and co-ordination of the Executive President, *act as* the Commission Chair Holders *or* Continental Representatives (Aug 11) The Secretary-General shall be provided with copies of all official correspondence originated by the Vice-Presidents.
- **4.9** Whenever the IDBF does not have an Honorary President, the Senior Vice-President shall assist the President in these duties and in representing the IDBF.
