

### **Confirmed entries**

The Championships will be the largest World Dragon Boat Racing Championships ever held, anywhere! As at the date of this Bulletin, some 4,000 athletes (plus nearly 700 official supporters) representing 33 member countries have entered a total of 1,288 crews. The previous largest World Dragon Boat Racing Championship was Kunming (2017) which had 3,300 athletes and 938 crews. With so many athletes and so much racing, the atmosphere is bound to be electric – an experience to treasure regardless of results.

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# **Team Managers Meeting**

The Team Managers' Meeting will take place on Monday, 14 July 2025 at 9:00 a.m. in the "Propeller" meeting room at the venue (What3Words: <a href="https://w3w.co/clutter.limit.alien">https://w3w.co/clutter.limit.alien</a>). This will be followed by briefings on the starting procedure for the 2000m.

All teams are invited to send up to three representatives per participating country to this briefing. The briefing will also be streamed so other team officials who are unable to attend can still see the proceedings.

# **Team Registration**

The registration office will be in the building on the sports club grounds near the venue entrance (What3Words: <a href="https://w3w.co/pirates.spells.mostly">https://w3w.co/pirates.spells.mostly</a>).

The office will be open only on:

- Saturday, 12 July from 1 pm to 5 pm
- Sunday, 13 July from 9 am to 5 pm

Teams must book their registration appointment time via https://idbfchamps.org/ and click on BOOKED REGISTRATION.

Bookings are essential. The link to book a registration time will open from Saturday 21 June at 12.00 UTC. Teams who do not book a registration slot will be required to wait until staff are able to process them.

### Checks on conformance to CR4 (Representation and nationality)

The IDBF World Dragon Boat Racing Championships provides the highest level of participation and competition that any dragon boat athlete can currently aspire to. IDBF wishes to ensure that the Championships in Brandeburg are undertaken with the appropriate high standards of participation integrity. Therefore, to help ensure that national teams conform to the requirements of CR4, spot checks will be conducted by IDBF during the Championships.

These checks will require participants selected by IDBF to prove that they meet the requirements of Competition Regulation CR4 by presenting to the IDBF their passports to confirm their citizenship. Where a selected athlete/participant is a citizen of country different to the one they are representing, proof of a residency visa (conforming to CR4) will also be required.

If the check is conducted before racing, any non-conforming athlete will not be permitted to race. If the check is conducted after a non-conforming paddler has raced, then their team is likely to incur penalties (which could include disqualification). Team managers are therefore encouraged to ensure that all their participants meet the requirements of CR4.

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
# Regatta venue and facilities


#### **Team tents**

The Athletes' Village is located in Area 8. Tents appropriately sized for the number of participants are available for all nations. If you would like to rent additional tents, email <a href="wdbrc2025@drachenboot.de">wdbrc2025@drachenboot.de</a> with your booking request. The standard size tent offered is 5m x 5m but other sizes may also be available upon request. 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### **Training**

- Crew Official Training sessions bookings are to be completed electronically on the online registration site: <a href="https://idbfchamps.org">https://idbfchamps.org</a> and by then clicking on BOOKED TRAINING (note this button may not be visible until just before bookings open).
- The online registration system will open from **Saturday 21 June at 12:00 UTC** to book training sessions (to verify the current UTC time use <a href="https://time.is/UTC">https://time.is/UTC</a>).
- Official Training sessions in both standard and small boats are available on Saturday 12 July and Sunday 13 July, from 9 am 6 pm each day. The last session is 6pm.
- There will be 10 sessions every day per boat.
- There will be 20 standard boats and 20 small boats per training session available.
- The length of one session is 45 minutes <u>maximum</u>.
- Crews can begin to board from 10 min before their allotted training sessions. Regardless of the time of boarding, the finish time will always be per the booking schedule.

- Should the Organising Committee, in consultation with the IDBF, deem it necessary and the conditions allow, additional practices <u>may</u> be added.

- The 'cup' starting system will be available to crews on both days (and will be operating at the 1000m start line).
- The 2000m Start procedure will also be operating both days (by the grandstand / finish tower). Please note the instructions in Appendix 1.
- Crews who are unable to train on the Saturday or Sunday because of their arrival time at the venue,
   will not be given priority over other crews should training be made available on the Monday morning.

### **Boats and boat pool**

For these World Championships, the boat pool will comprise of 25 Standard and 25 small High Performance Racing Dragon Boats from BuK Germany, all conforming to IDBF specifications. The only boats permitted to be used will be boats from this pool.

All boats will have pre-installed speaker systems compatible with NK Cox Boxes.

#### **Boat Allocation**

Crews will be allocated a boat in accordance with the Lane Draws shown in the Race Programme; crews will NOT be allowed to select a boat for any race.

### Water quality of Lake Beetzsee

Lake Beetzsee is a natural freshwater inland lake.



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# Double Rostering (Competitors in more than one competition racing class)

Team Managers are advised that no allowance will be made in the Race Programme for any competitors who are double rostered. Crews with double rostered competitors (and this includes drummer and helms) are advised that in the event of 'back-to-back' racing arising, Race Officials will not delay races.

#### **Drones**

Drones are not permitted to be flown at the Regatta venue by all participants and spectators under any circumstances.

# Racing Vest Number (race number bibs)

Teams should provide their own sets of Racing Vest Numbers or race number bibs (01-26 resp. 1 - 14). The IDBF Organising Committee can, if requested, provide vest numbers for purchase by pre-ordering. Team Managers will be able to collect their pre-ordered Racing Numbers when they register at the Accreditation Office of the Organising Committee. Orders for Racing Vest Numbers must be submitted before 15 June.

#### **Crew Lists**

All crew lists showing the competitors and reserves who will be racing in a particular competition class should be submitted by the team leader or crew manager to the Race Administration, as early as possible. However, Team Managers are required to submit crew lists to Race Administration by the close of play the day before the event commences.

Once racing commences, requests for changes to crew lists will only be accepted if they relate to a medical condition and the change has been agreed by the Chief Officials. Team managers are reminded that Crew Lists provide for 'reserves,' so a temporary absence of a participant should ordinarily be covered by one of the nominated reserves.

Crew lists must be printed; handwritten crew lists will not be accepted. It is recommended that crew lists are generated from the IDBF online database so that PIN numbers and QR codes are automatically included (the latter to assist Boat Marshals). This facility is available after team named lists have been entered online at <a href="https://idbfchamps.org/">https://idbfchamps.org/</a>.

Race Administration will have a printer and computer available for those teams wishing to print their crew lists at the venue. However, this facility will be 'first come, first served' and failure to submit a crew list on time because of a queue for the computer and printer will not be considered a valid excuse.

Please be aware that the registration system for preparing crew lists does not include the rules of the crew composition. It is the responsibility of the team manager to ensure that each crew complies with the relevant rules.

Fit to Race: You are reminded that when signing the crew list, the person signing confirms with the Chief Official that all the competitors shown on the list are fit to race. This statement covers not just the physical ability of the competitors to undertake the race concerned but it also means that the signatory is confirming that there are no known medical reasons why those listed should not compete during the whole period of the Championships.



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#### 2000m Races

The 2000m races in Brandenburg will be conducted over a course with <u>four</u> turns (rather than the more usual three).

### **IDBF Registration Fees**

The IDBF registration fee is **USD 50 per person** and **USD 25** for athletes aged 25 years and under.

The IDBF Deputy treasurer will provide an invoice for this payment, which will contain the bank details.

Please note the timelines:

Named entries closed 15 May

Invoices will be sent out 30 June

Payment due by 30 June

IDBF will not refund registration fees for registered attendees who cancel after the payment of the invoice.

It is the responsibility of the participating member to ensure the full amount shown on the IDBF invoice is received by the IDBF. The IDBF will send an updated invoice once the money is received, and this invoice will show any outstanding fees. Any bank fees remain the responsibility of the participating member and these can be paid in cash in US dollars at the time of registration.

The registration fee is the only money payable to the IDBF; all other Event fees are payable to the Organising Committee.

Accreditation cards permitting participation in the Championships will only be issued once full payment of all monies owed to IDBF have been received.

#### **National Flags**

National flags for medal ceremonies and Opening Ceremony (for flag bearers) will be provided by the Organising Committee. Countries are encouraged to bring additional national flags which can be displayed in team tents.

#### **Anthems**

Please check your National Anthem at <a href="https://idbfchamps.org/anthems.php?event">https://idbfchamps.org/anthems.php?event</a> id=51 (Anthems interface). If you require a change or need to add your anthem, please upload an MP3 file or MP4 audio file in the National Federation system or in the Event Registration system opened for the current Championships, that is <a href="https://idbfchamps.org/">https://idbfchamps.org/</a>.

To ensure the anthem is correct it is expected to be **approved in the last two weeks before the Championships** by the Team Manager or a person representing the National Federation concerned.

It can be done either in the public Anthems interface or in the Event Registration system - ENTRY FORM interface.

The final date for submission is **30 June**.



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#### **Media Accreditation**

The media accreditation process for the 17th IDBF World Dragon Boat Racing Championships is now open.

The organising committee is preparing a massage station for athletes during the World Championship week.






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# **Appendix 1 – Instructions for 2000m races**



 The 2000-meter races during the 17th WDBRC in Brandenburg will be completed with four turns.

- Races will be held in lanes 2 and 7.
- The pre-start will take place 30 meters before the actual start line, which is the same as the finish line.
- The starting process will take place with an acoustic and visual countdown. Follow the link to watch and hear an example. <u>THE COMPETITION 17th World Dragon Boat Racing Championships</u> The timing will be automatically triggered when the boats crosses this start line (finish tower.)
- Each team will receive its own race time as usual. The first turn is straight after the start!
- The straight stretch between the turns is 415 meters.
- Each team has the opportunity to test that procedure during the trainings sessions Saturday and Sunday.



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# **Appendix 2 - Paradragons**

Athletes Village. Paradragon teams will be co-located with their national teams in the Athletes village but also provided with specific facilities for their own use. Transport will be provided to move mobility- impaired athletes from designated car parking to the Athletes village. Matting will be laid between the village to boat marshalling and in the medal presentation area to provide a suitable surface for wheelchair users.

**At-venue assessments**. Selected athletes will be subjected to at-venue assessments per Rules for Paradragon Racing. These will be conducted at the venue doping control centre on Saturday 12<sup>th</sup> and Sunday 13<sup>th</sup> July. The doping control centre is at https://migrate.betrayed.taker. The names of those athletes selected for at-venue assessment will be notified to team managers in advance. Failure to attend an assessment at the date and time specified may result in changes to the assigned impairment score (that will not be able to be appealed) or even refusal to permit the athlete to race as a Paradragon.

**Buoyancy aids**. Should the Safety Officer mandate the wearing of buoyancy aids, crews are reminded that sufficient buoyancy aids will be available at the venue and that there is therefore no requirement for athletes to bring their own. The decision of the Safety Officer will be made in light of the conditions and athletes need not wear one unless this decision is made (or the individual or crew makes their own decision to do so).

**Chaperones**. Chaperones are the only non-crew member permitted in marshalling and in the boat loading / unloading area. Access will be controlled and only those with Chaperone accreditation will be provided with the necessary passes. Applications for Chaperone passes must be made directly to:

chair-para@dragonboat.sport by 27th June.

Applications must state the name(s) of the athletes they will be supporting and why a chaperone is required.

**Double-rostering**. IDBF will allow 'double rostering' by PD2 crew members (both impaired and unimpaired). In this way, Paradragon crew members should be able to participate in other race divisions, classes, and boat sizes. It may also provide opportunities for 'reserves' in other classes to get more races than they might otherwise. In short, IDBF is determined to encourage both impaired and unimpaired athletes to race in the Paradragon class.

Declaration 1 & 2 submissions have already begun with Nations being individually invited to submit. For those still needing to submit, please only complete ONCE! If there is no email confirmation, please first check Spam/Junk folders. If there is still no confirmation email, please contact <a href="mailto:support@dragonboat.sport">support@dragonboat.sport</a>.

Declaration 2 copies should be filed in racing classes for easy retrieval by the Team Manager.

Declarations should be completed by 30th June. Random checks will be made from 1<sup>st</sup> July

## **Appendix 4 – Anti Doping Requirements**



#### Don't leave it to do in Brandenburg!

Completion of an appropriate anti-doping course **by 15<sup>th</sup> June** is mandatory for all **Premier, Senior A, Senior B, Senior C, 24U, 18U and Paradragons** racing classes (not age) athletes plus ALL coaches competing in the WNDBRC 2025 to receive their accreditation.

Team Managers please ensure your team members complete the appropriate anti-doping course and that you have a copy of each athlete's Anti-Doping Course certificate. Certificates should be filed in racing class for easy retrieval. Random checks will be made from 16<sup>th</sup> June


#### **BCP**

All BCP athletes are required to have a Declaration of Diagnosis Certificate. Copies of these certificates are to be held by the Team Manager and shown on request of an IDBF Official.

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### **Competitor's Rights**

- Be notified of selection for doping control
- Be informed of the consequences of refusing to provide a sample
- Have the doping control procedures explained
- Be provided with a selection of sealed equipment from which to choose
- Be observed when providing sample by someone of the same gender
- Receive copies of all signed documentation

### **Competitors Responsibilities**

- Know the IDBF and your IDBF's Member anti-doping regulations.
- Carry photo ID to present to the Doping Control Office (DCO)
- Inform your doctor or pharmacist that you are a competitor who may be subject to doping control.
- Consult your IDBF Member in advance if you are medically required to take any medication
  on the prohibited list before being permitted to take such substances, you will need to
  apply for medical exemption and therapeutic use exemption (TUE).
- Keep a list of all medications, vitamins, or supplements you are taking and declare them on the doping control form.
- Be careful with unlicensed products such as nutritional supplements or herbal products as they may contain prohibited substances.
- From notification through to completion of sample collection, stay in full view of the DCO or chaperone, whether at a Competition, Training Venue or your home.
- Re-hydrate with sealed non-alcoholic, caffeine-free beverage before the test.
- Be prepared to begin sample collection procedures as soon as possible after notification.
- Strict Liability if it is in the athlete's body, the athlete is responsible for it.
